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CityMade moves to suburbs

[CityMade Inc./Made in Buffalo](#), a firm that assembles and sells boxed gift packages of local culinary favorites, has signed a deal for a new operations center.

The firm has agreed to lease 12,000 square feet in the [Riverview Commerce Park](#) in the Town of Tonawanda, where its operations will be headquartered. It's moving from downtown Buffalo.

The new location will house CityMade's two divisions, a wholesale and retail gift arm and a fulfillment and logistics division.

The deal was handled by Jeff LiPuma and Shana Stenger from the [CB Richard Ellis/Buffalo](#) office.

With the deal, the 400 Riverwalk Parkway Building is about 90 percent leased. Just 8,000 square feet in the 56,686-square-foot building remain.

Thomas Montante, Riverview Commerce Park's developer, has started construction on a 104,000-square-foot building that will feature a mix of office and warehouse space. That building should be completed by September.

In addition, CB Richard Ellis/Buffalo also brokered a deal that saw Lakeshore Behavioral Health lease 4,500 square feet in Buffalo's Towne Gardens Plaza. Towne Gardens is located on William Street on Buffalo's East Side.
